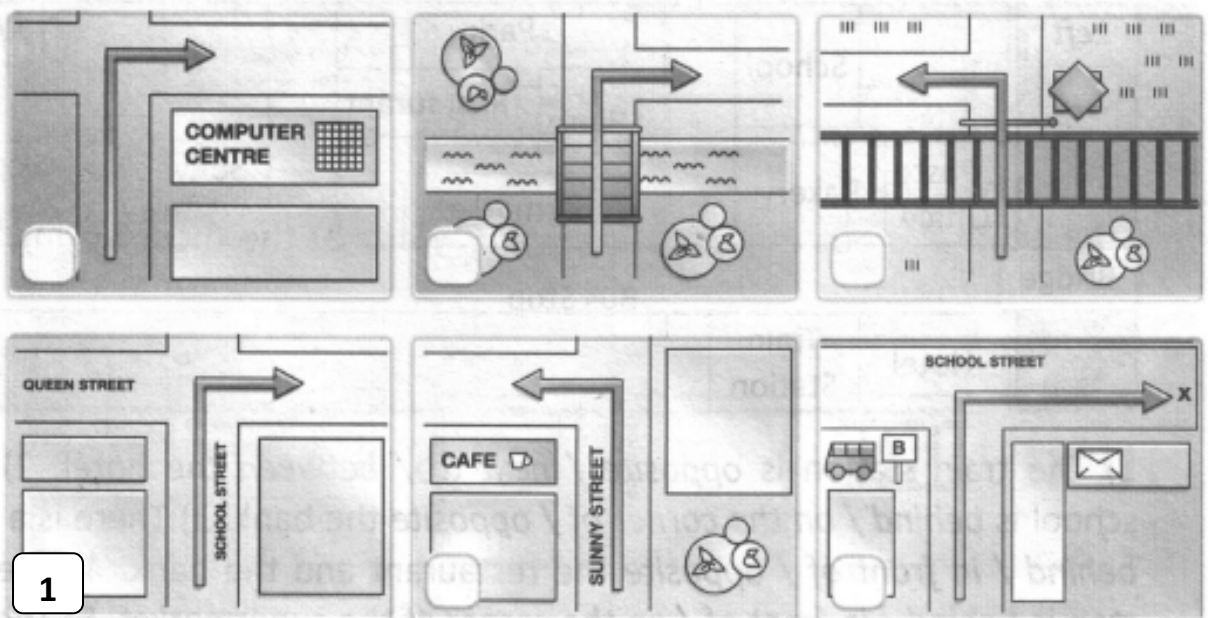

- 6) Go along the street, then cross the river over the bridge and turn right.

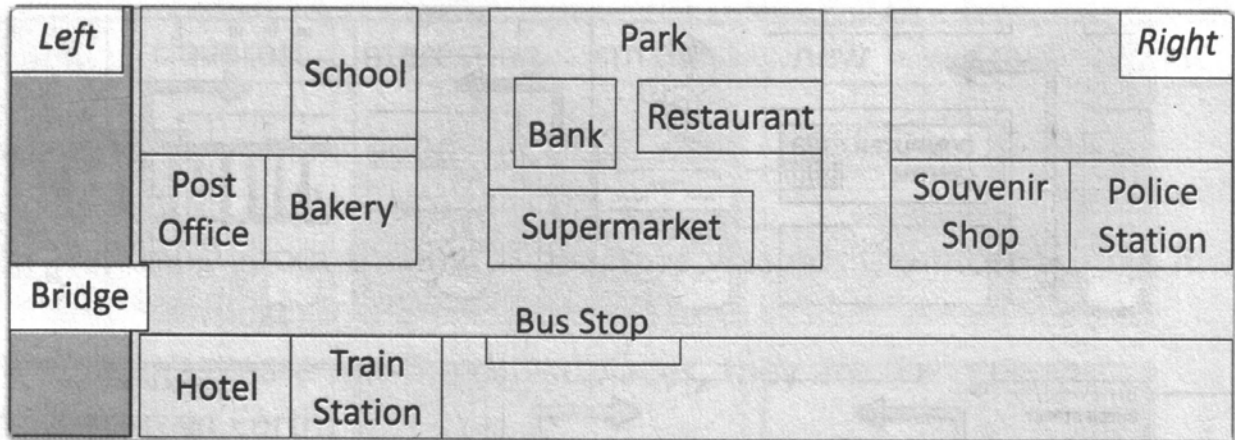
